Student Expectations

 - Why?
- Communicate absences in a timely manner
 - Includes completing Tournament Absence Form at least 2 weeks in advance
- Volunteer at **AT LEAST** 1 fundraiser shift

Parent/Guardian Expectations

- Pay all fees and costs associated with Speech
- Judge at 2 tournaments (per student)
 - If you know you cannot judge, you can buy out your judging commitment
 - \$80 for one tournament, \$160 for two tournaments (per student)
- Read weekly emails

Tournament Day in the Life


- Arrive at ERHS between 6:30am-7:00am (depending on load time)
- Travel with team to regional schools for tournaments
- Participate in team warmups prior to competition
- Compete from roughly 8:30am-3:00pm (varies based on tournament)
- Attend final rounds and awards ceremony
- Arrive back at ERHS between 4:30pm-5:30pm

Students are expected to arrive early or on time for bus load time. Failure to do so may result in needing to find your own transportation.


Costs
